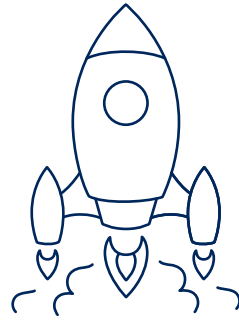


ESTABLISHED

Under the leadership of the Director of Digital Learning, we formed a team of 12 – a project manager, graphic designer, quality assurance coordinator, instructional technologist, 2 videographers and 6 instructional designers.
