



One-stop Job Search Workshop Pre- and Post-test

Administered: Spring Semester 2003

Target Population: All students attending the Onestop Job Search workshop

A One-stop Job Search workshop on the elements of the job search was offered to all students interested in obtaining employment. The students who participated in this workshop were administered a pre- and post-test at the time of the workshop to assess learning outcomes. The average overall rating for the pre-test was 2.26 (1-5 scale with 5 being the highest) and the average overall rating for the post-test was 3.46, a 1.2 increase in knowledge after attending the workshop.
